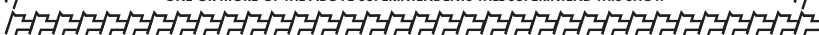

## Attention Owners/Exhibitors of Foreign Registered Dogs

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1.

The dog show rules are posted on the AKC Web site at: <http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf>

Most important to note are the following:

1. Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class.
2. Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, *regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards*. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. The owner or agent can request an extension using the form found on the AKC Web site at: <http://images.akc.org/pdf/extenap.pdf>

**PUBLICATION RIGHTS:** By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

## AKC National Owner-Handled Series

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

## POINTS FOR RESERVE AT ANY SPECIALTY – REVISION EFFECTIVE JULY 3, 2024

--- READ VERY CAREFULLY ---

### Chapter 16, Section 1 Rules Applying to Dog Shows

...at a Specialty the dog designated Reserve Winners Dog and the bitch designated Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winners' sex totals at least TWICE the number required for a five-point major, in the region in which the event is held. No major for Reserve Winners shall be given based upon an award of Best of Winners.

## NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that neutered males may be entered as a Veteran Dog in a Veteran Dog Class and spayed bitches may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in a Veteran Bitch class.

**NR1.08100.23500. Veteran Classes** - Class for dogs & class for bitches who are 8 years & under 10 years.

**NR1.08100.38000. Veteran Classes** - Class for dogs & class for bitches who are 10 years & under 12 years.

**NR1.08100.38400. Veteran Classes** - Class for dogs & class for bitches who are 12 years & over.

**NR1.21800. Hunting Retriever Classes.** Class for dogs & class for bitches that have earned an AKC Junior, Senior, or Master Hunter title, Field Championship, Amateur Field Championship or achieved Qualified All-Age Status in AKC Field Test, under AKC rules. **The Hunting Retriever may be spayed or neutered.**

**Please be aware the Upland Hunting Test titles do not qualify for a dog for this event.**

Winners of the above Non-Regular Classes, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible to compete for Best of Breed Competition.

**Judge's Award of Merit:** Awards of Merit may be awarded to those Golden Retrievers competing in Best of Breed competition that are not awarded Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog or Select Bitch. The maximum number of Awards of Merit will be 10% of the total number of entries in the Best of Breed class at the time entries close (rounded up to the next whole number). Non-regular class winners and move-ups will not be included in the calculation but are eligible for awards. GRCA Resolution NS19-85

**Best Puppy:** After Best of Breed, Selects and Awards of Merit are chosen, the winners of Puppy Dog & Bitch 6-9 months and 9-12 months, Bred by Exhibitor Puppy Dog 6-12 months and Bred by Exhibitor Puppy Bitch 6-12 months compete for Best Puppy. If the entry has been defeated by another puppy (Winners or Reserve), the entry is not eligible to compete for Best Puppy. If Best of Winners is from either the 6-9 month, 9-12 month or Bred by Exhibitor Puppy 6-12 month Class, that entry is automatically Best Puppy.

**Best Bred by Exhibitor:** After Best of Breed, Selects and Awards of Merit are chosen, the winners of Bred by Exhibitor Dog and Bred by Exhibitor Bitch, (Puppy and Adult) compete for Best Bred by Exhibitor. If Best of Winners is from any Bred by Exhibitor class, that entry is automatically Best Bred by Exhibitor.

**Best Veteran:** After Best of Breed, Selects and Awards of Merit are chosen, the winners of Non-Regular Veteran Dog & Veteran Bitch classes compete for Best Veteran.
